Yasir Ali Khan (PMS) Assumes Charge as CEO WSSP



Yasir Ali Khan (PMS) has assumed charge as the new Chief Executive Officer of Water and Sanitation Services Peshawar (WSSP). After assuming charge, he was briefed by heads of various departments on operational, administrative, and financial matters. General Manager Operations Muhammad Ijaz, General Manager PMER Syed Zamir-ul-Hassan, General Manager Projects Dr. Mehboob Alam, Chief Internal Audit Mian Asif Shah, and Chief Financial Officer Haider Ali briefed him on service delivery, financial status, ongoing projects, and other affairs.

He instructed team WSSP to ensure efficient use of available resources to guarantee timely service delivery and intensify efforts to improve service quality. He expressed the commitment to enhance services and steps to address challenges.



CEO Visits Operational Sites, Directs for Expansion of Model Street Initiative

Chief Executive Officer, Water and Sanitation Services Peshawar (WSSP), Yasir Ali Khan, visited Zone A, B, C & D and inspected operational activities and sites. General Manager Muhammad Ijaz, zonal managers Basith Khattak, Tariq Aziz, Anwar-ul-Haq, and Amir Gul Khattak accompanied him. During visit to Zone A, he appreciated door-to-door waste collection in selected areas and directed that waste be collected in line with global standards and emphasized raising public awareness to encourage people to dispose of waste properly, use bags and place waste at designated points to prevent open dumping. He called on zonal authorities to devise strategy for door-to-door waste collection campaign in commercial areas. He directed zonal authorities to expand Model Street Initiative to ensure sustainable cleanliness and timely provision of quality services throughout the city. It is worth noting that WSSP has



eradicated undesigned waste disposal points in at different locations and placed flower pots and planted plants there with the support of locals and traders. Yasir Ali Khan emphasized to expand the Model Street Initiative, the cooperation of traders, shopkeepers, elected representatives, and the general public should be sought to ensure continuous cleanliness, prevent pollution, and foster a sense of responsibility among people.

CEO asked zonal officials to closely monitor and ensure the presence of all employees in the field, all secondary-level garbage collection vehicles must be operational daily to avoid disruption in operations. He stated that special attention should be given to secondary-level operations, and a plan be formulated to ensure complete cleanliness in all areas, the utilization of vehicles should align with their capacity, and performance should be improved within available resources. He



acknowledged that WSSP is performing well compared to other sanitation entities.

Yasir Ali Khan praised community members and WSSP field officers for their efforts in maintaining model streets and asked that community members involved in look after of streets should be honoured with certificates and shields to encourage others. Zonal Managers briefed him on routine operations and other activities in zones. He was informed that roads are cleaned at night, field officers conduct awareness and public engagement sessions daily to ensure community involvement. Yasir Ali Khan emphasized for diligent performance and timely service delivery and directed staff to promptly lift waste from collection points and improve container management to prevent garbage overflow, curb waste disposal at unauthorized spots and make collection points easily accessible to the public.

WSSP Launches Moonsoon Tree Plantation Drive

The Water and Sanitation Services Peshawar (WSSP) has launched the Monsoon Tree Plantation drive as part of the provincial government's Billion Tree Plus initiative. The official inauguration of the tree plantation was conducted by Chairman DDAC Peshawar, Member Provincial Assembly, Sher Ali Afridi, alongside Secretary Local Government, Mohammad Daud Khan, Commissioner Peshawar, and acting Chief Executive Officer WSSP, Riaz Khan Mehsud. Deputy Commissioner Peshawar, Captain (R) Sarmad Saleem Akram, Chief Conservator Forests, Kashif Baloch, General Manager PMER WSSP, Syed Zameer-ul-Hassan, General Manager Operations,

Mohammad Ejaz, and other officials of district administration and WSSP were also present.

In the first phase of the plantation drive, nearly 3,000 ornamental and non-ornamental plants and trees will be planted at dumping sites, transfer stations, and other locations. For the first phase, Forest Department has provided 1,900 plants, while WSSP has purchased hundreds of plants from its own resources.

MPA Sher Ali Afridi, stated that in line with the instructions of the Chief Minister, all departments have been given a target for planting trees. To combat the impacts of climate change, a greater emphasis will be placed on planting trees. The government recognizes the importance of tree planting, and

the Billion Tree Plus initiative is focused on planting more trees to mitigate the effects of climate change.

Secretary Local Government, Mohammad Daud Khan, emphasized that the most effective way to address the impacts of climate change is planting more trees. Following the Chief Minister's directions, efforts are being made to plant as many trees as possible during the monsoon season, in this regard instructions have been issued to all TMAs across the province, despite limited resources, the set target will be met. He called on the public to actively participate in the campaign by planting trees.

Riaz Mehsud, highlighted the need to make efficient use of



available resources to take full advantage of the opportunity. He pointed out that environmental changes are occurring due to global warming and the melting of glaciers, which brought many challenges that are being addressed through various measures. He added that future generations will face challenges related to water and floods, and to mitigate these, more trees must be planted. He also instructed the Deputy Commissioners in Peshawar Division to monitor the plantation efforts of departments.

Chief Conservator Forests, Kashif Baloch, stated that millions of trees are being planted across the province under the moonsoon plantation drive in line with the provincial government's directives to increase the forested area.



LG Minister Arshad Ayub Distribute Prizes Among WSSP Employees



Provincial Minister for Local Government, Elections & Rural Development, Arshad Ayub Khan, has stated that institutional reforms being introduced in the local government department and its subsidiary wings. Efforts are underway to digitize the department. He emphasized a commitment to eradicating corruption and strengthening institutions, adding that employees with excellent performance will be encouraged, while those with poor performance will be guided for improvement.

He made these remarks during a ceremony to distribute cash rewards and certificates among Water and Sanitation Services Peshawar (WSSP) employees for their exceptional performance during the Eid-ul-Adha operation. Secretary Local Government Muhammad Daud Khan, Commissioner Peshawar and acting CEO WSSP, Riaz Mehsud also addressed the gathering. Members of WSSP Board, and management officials attended the event. The provincial minister awarded cash prizes to 52 employees and certificates to 17 management officials.

The minister highlighted the province-wide cleanliness campaign during Eid-ul-Adha, noting WSSP's exemplary performance in Peshawar. "The government allocates PKR 7 billion annually for

seven sanitation companies in the province, however, the caretaker government had temporarily halted the payments for essential services, creating challenges for WSSP and other institutions" he said and informed that due to Chief Minister Ali Amin Gandapur's interest, significant outstanding payments to WSSP and other entities have been cleared.

He said that solely relying on government funds is not sustainable; institutions need to reduce their dependency on grants by increasing revenue independently. He said, "The government is considering various options, including granting additional powers to institutions, to increase transparency and revenue". He lauded workers for their dedication, noting that WSSCs and TMAs' staff performing challenging duties and assured continuous support for institutions and encouragement of employees.

Secretary LG Daud Khan highlighted that WSSP's teamwork led to a successful cleanliness campaign during Eid-ul-Adha, which was praised by the government and public alike.

Riaz Mehsud said that WSSP met the government's expectations during Eid-ul-Adha, staff performed exceptionally well. and penalty system has been implemented.



Muharram-ul-Haram: WSSP Provides Round-the-Clock Services

Water and Sanitation Services Peshawar (WSSP) provided 24/7 services during the 10-days of Ashura Muharram. To ensure cleanliness and water supply for processions and gatherings, WSSP implemented a 10-day special plan. A total of 320 personnel performed duties in day and night shifts. They carried out continuous cleaning and water sprinkling along the procession routes. WSSP staff also performed duties at the Supreme Command Post, while areas in Zone A and Zone B, including those hosting processions and gatherings, were consistently sprayed and treated with lime. WSSP management officials remained in the field around the clock for overseeing the operations to provide uninterrupted services.



Rabi-ul-Awwal: WSSP provides Sanitation and Water supply Services

Water and Sanitation Services Peshawar (WSSP) staff ensured cleanliness and water supply services for procession routes and gatherings during Rabi-ul-Awwal. For this purpose, WSSP management assigned special duties to the staff, who worked day and night. Water sprinkling and lime application were carried out along the procession routes. The staff remained on duty from the beginning to the conclusion of the Rabi-ul-Awwal processions and gatherings. In addition to cleaning and sprinkling, complaints were also promptly addressed.
