### **Special Cleaning Campaign Continues**

A 15-day special sanitation campaign is in progress with special emphasis on public awareness and removal of garbage heaps from undesignated sites. Outreach teams are conducting daily awareness walks, while operational staff are actively engaged in routine cleaning and elimination of unauthorized dumping points. Citizens

are being encouraged to use water responsibly, register illegal water connections, and conserve water for coming generations. In addition, antidengue activities are also underway, teams are carrying out spray in the morning and evening, and conducting door-to-door awareness campaigns.
